With respect to letter grades, 93-100 is an A, 90-92 an A-, 87-89 a B+, 83-86 a B, 80-82 a B-, 77-79 a C+, 73-76 a C, 70-72 a C-, 64-69 a D+, 56-63 a D, 50-55 a D-, and 0-49 an F. These are minimums. A curve might be applied at the end of the course.
