Course Description: Most of Chapters 1-8 will be covered. Detailed course outline will be given weekly in class.

Prerequisite: A grade of C or better in MA090 or satisfactory score on the Math Placement Exam.

Textbook: Understanding Intermediate Algebra, 5th Edition by Lewis Hirsch and Arthur Goodman.

Attendance: Students are expected to attend all the classes. Attendance will be taken at the beginning of the class.

Homework, Quizzes and Tests: Homework will be assigned for each class. There will be five tests scheduled for 05/22/08, 05/29/08, 06/03/08, 06/10/08, and 06/17/08, and a comprehensive two-hour final exam on 06/26/08. Each test counts 15% toward the final grade. The final exam counts 25%. It is important to take the tests and exam at the scheduled time. Generally, no make-ups will be given.
